Physical Therapy Milestones	[Y] [N] Demonstrates head control in all positions
	[Y] [N] Tolerates tummy time at least 1 hour a day (accumulative)
	[Y] [N] Rolls from Back to belly & belly to back
	[Y] [N] Pivots around on belly
	[Y] [N] Pulls to stand
	[Y] [N] Able to get into a hands & knees position
	[Y] [N] Sits independently for play (9 months)
Occupational Therapy Milestones	[Y] [N] Bangs 2 objects together
	[Y] [N] Plays with feet (grasping)
	[Y] [N] Intentionally drops objects to watch them fall
	[Y] [N] Swallows pureed foods
	[Y] [N] Picks up small finger foods by raking into palm
	[Y] [N] Can be comforted through touch
	[Y] [N] Explores toys with their mouth
Speech Therapy Milestones	[Y] [N] Babbles and makes a variety of sounds
	[Y] [N] Uses voice to express pleasure and displeasure
	[Y] [N] Pays attention to noise
	[Y] [N] Moves eyes in direction of sounds
	[Y] [N] Smiles and giggles
